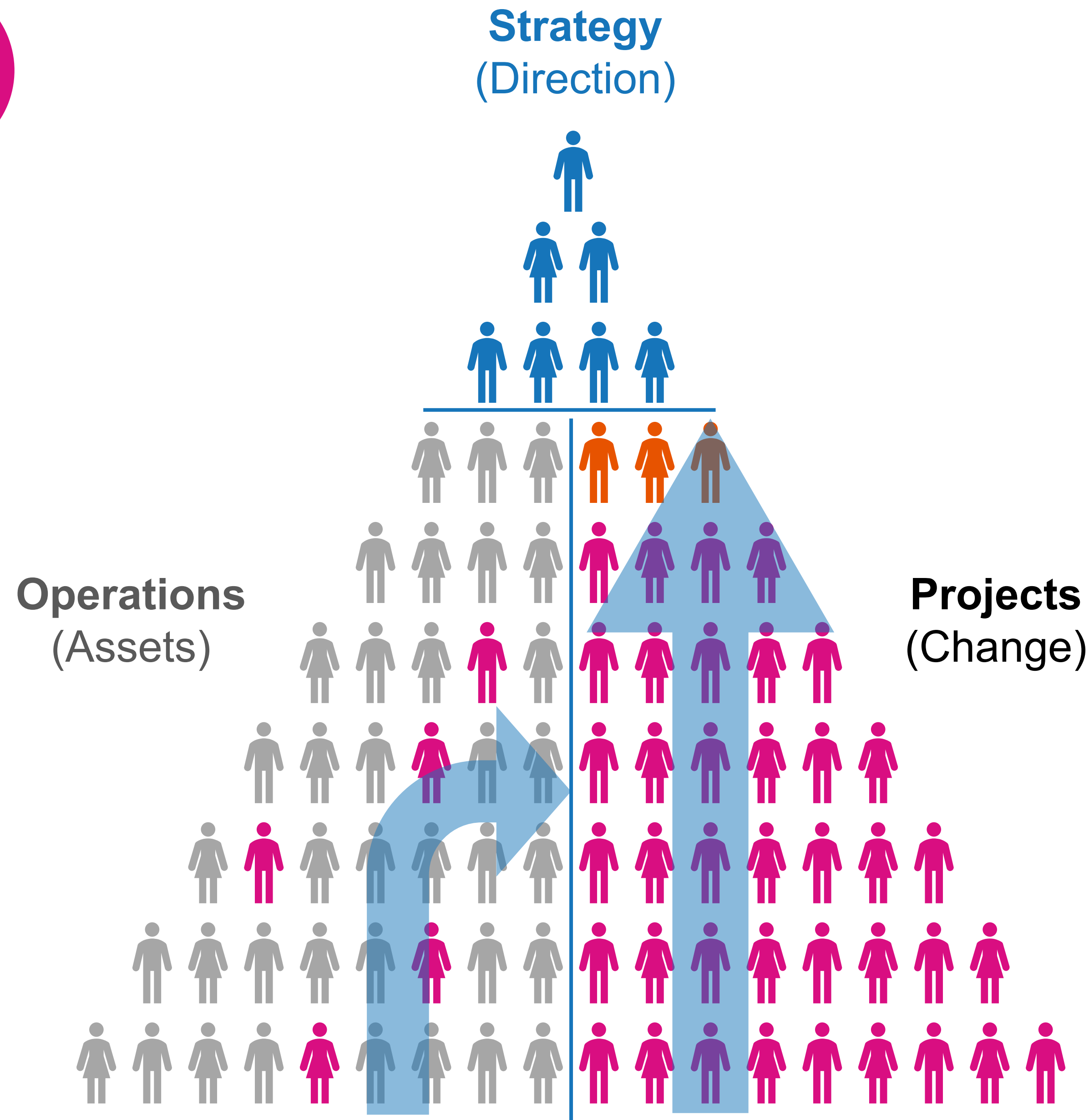


For Practitioners
