Tools of the Trade - Focus on the Objective



- Create an agenda ahead of time
 - Ask for input from the team
 - Specify meeting purpose desired outcome
 - Date, day, time, time zone, location, phone numbers
 - > Include item, responsible party, and time allotted
- Use an action/decision list
- Develop meeting ground rules and enforce them!

Sample Ground Rules

- Start and stop meetings on time 50 minute "hours"
- Everyone is expected to participate
- Leave job title at the door
- Avoid side tracking by keeping to scheduled time for each topic
- Respect each other's comments/opinions
- One person speaks at a time no side conversations
- Come prepared CHALLENGE THE STEPS TO THE PURPOSE!
- Actions/decisions will be assigned to an owner, with a due date
- HAVE FUN!
