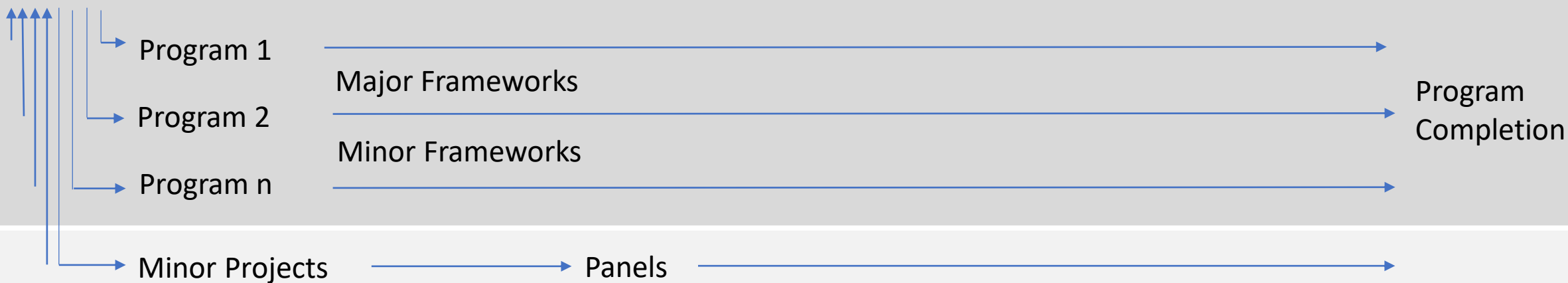


Evolution journey – programs & frameworks
